

First Universalist Church of Yarmouth Covid Reopening Policy

Effective September 1, 2020

First Universalist Church (First U) follows State of Maine and UUA guidelines. First U is reopen for approved uses of the building as of September 1, 2020, subject to change as conditions require or allow.

Approval for Use of Building: Any group or individual wishing to use the building will fill out the Building Use Agreement. Once approval is given, the group or individual agrees to follow all First U Procedures.

Cleaning, Disinfecting and Sanitizing Policy: The following procedures are used to keep staff, volunteers and visitors healthy and safe:

1. All common surfaces, doorknobs, and light switches in allowed use areas will be sprayed with a soap solution and then wiped with a disinfectant prior to each approved use.
2. Staff/volunteers will wear gloves while cleaning, disinfecting, and emptying trash.
3. Floors will be cleaned regularly.
4. Soap and paper towels will be available for handwashing.
5. Sanitizer will be available
6. Touchless trash cans will be placed in the common areas.
7. Appropriate signage will be displayed regarding health and safety in public areas.
8. Use of all cloth covered furniture is off limits until further notice.
